### Part-Time and Concurrent Senior Fees

These fees apply to students approved for taking three or fewer credits at New Hope Academy and/or seeking concurrent credits for outside courses or internships undertaken elsewhere. Students who need to take more than three credit courses at New Hope Academy will be enrolled as full-time students.

In order to receive a High School diploma from New Hope Academy, a student must be enrolled in our school for at least one academic year and must complete all graduation requirements.
